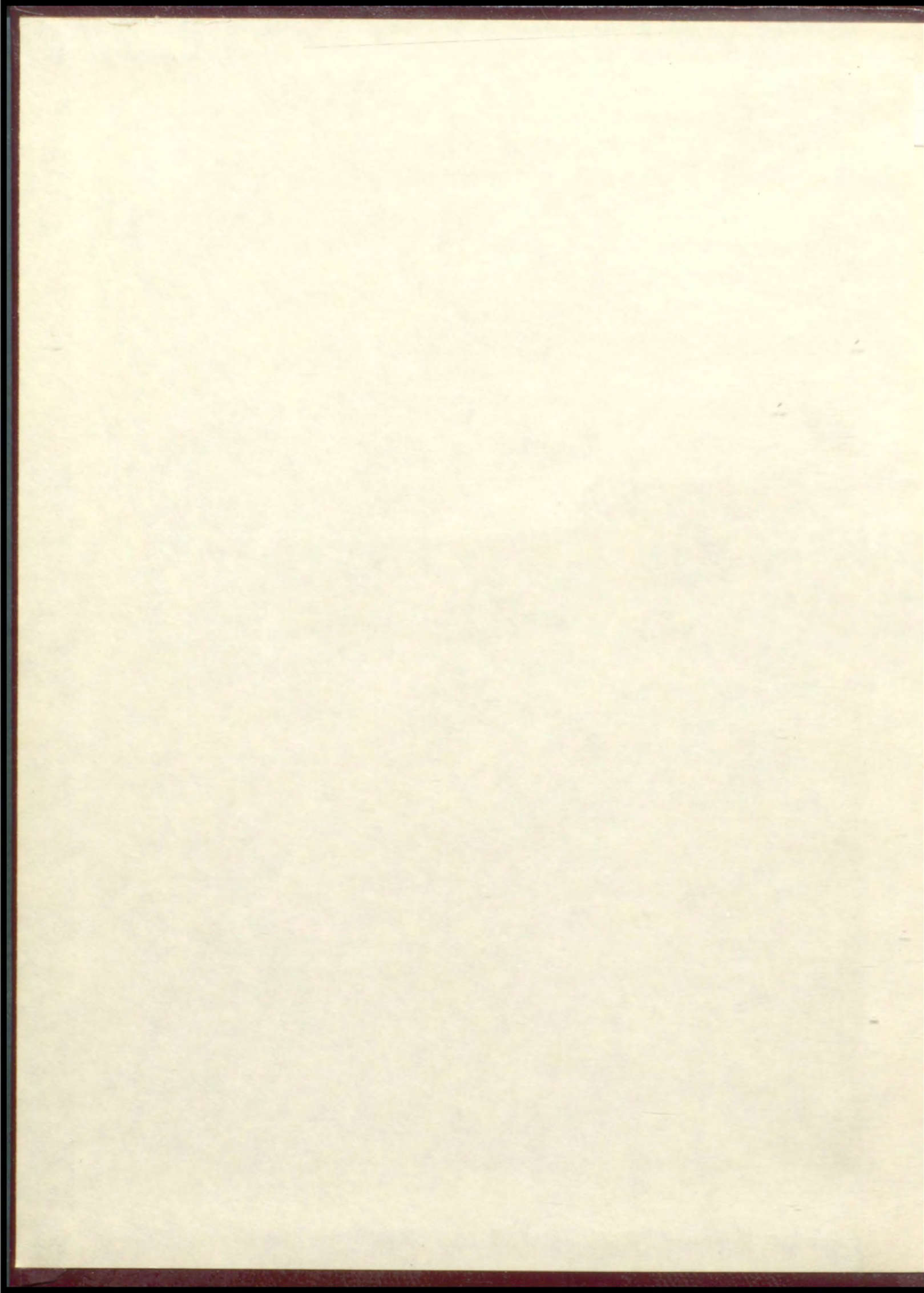

The 1976 Viking Annual is Dedicated to the Late Gladyce L. Moody

Mrs. Moody was born September 17, 1908 in Plainville, Illinois. She graduated from Quincy High School and attended Western Illinois University in Macomb.

Mrs. Moody taught school for over forty years. Prior to teaching in Cambridge, she taught in Adams county near Quincy, Illinois; at Osco School of Orion School District, and at Munson Center School of Geneseo School District.

In 1951 Mrs. Moody started the kindergarten program at Cambridge. She taught 2nd and 3rd grade in the Cambridge School district up until her retirement in 1973.

Mrs. Moody was very active in the school and community. She was the first president of Cambridge P.T.A. She was a member of the Illinois Angus Auxiliary, the Eastern Star, Osco Grange and the Retired Teachers Association.

Mrs. Moody was loved by her many students and fellow teachers. Because of her dedication to the school, we dedicate this 1976 yearbook to the memory of Mrs. Gladyce L. Moody.

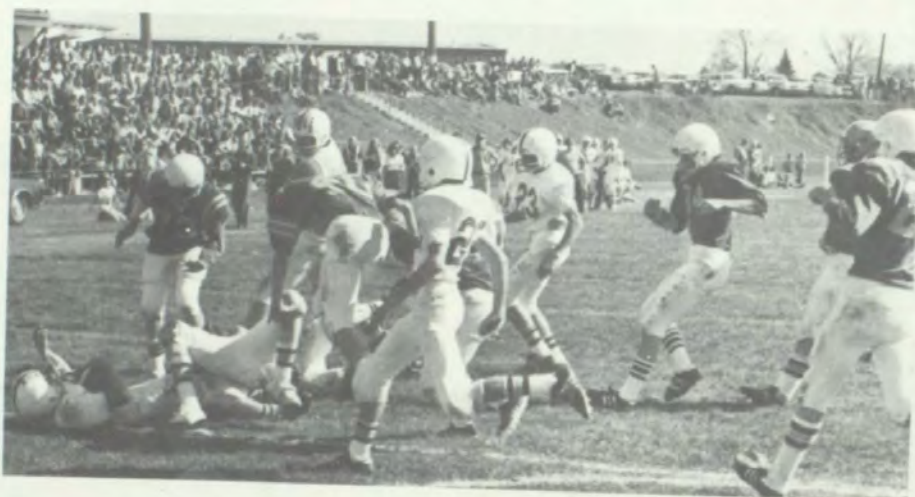

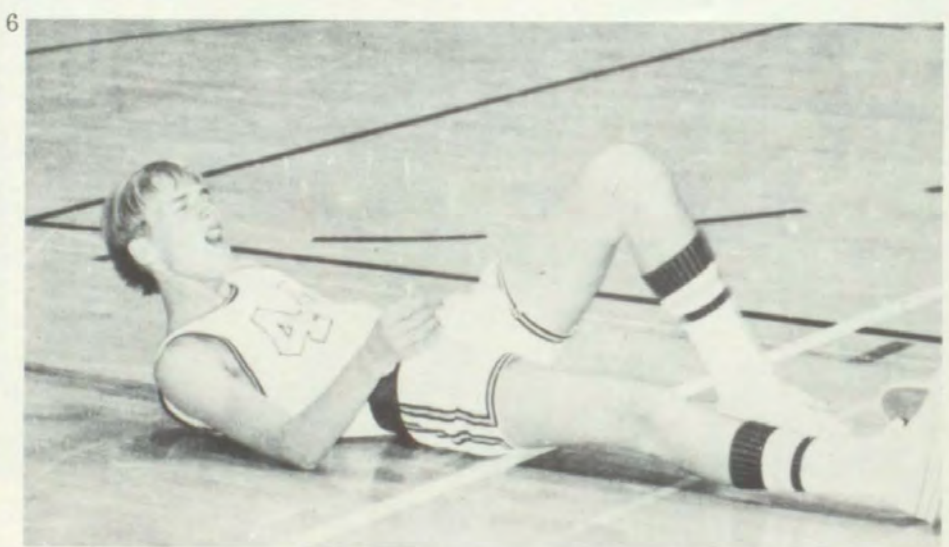
